This includes governmental agencies, veterinarians, animal control officers, humane organizations, and citizen volunteers. LSART works as a volunteer ESF-11 partner in Louisiana's emergency planning structure.



What we do...

- Assist state, parish and local agencies in planning and preparing for all types of emergencies involving all animals
- Register teams of volunteers in companion animal, equine and food animal sections
- Provide training in NIMS, ICS, evacuation protocols, shelter management, and other aspects of emergency planning
- Exercise emergency animal evacuation and sheltering protocols with communities and agencies throughout the state
- Offer community training and messaging for emergency preparedness
- Oversee state credentialing of volunteers and out-of-state partners and provides task assignments
- Respond to emergencies by assisting with evacuation, sheltering, and search and rescue
